Dear Parishioners...

According to the Gospel of Saint Luke. The disciples could not "believe" that Jesus had made himself present: it was their imagination. They thought that what they saw was a ghost. Wanting to feel his hands and feet impeded their faith. It was necessary for their understanding to be opened, to grasp that what happened, was announced in Scripture. Jesus explains to them and this is how they manage to pass from sensitive evidence to faith. The signs that strengthen our faith are:

1° The testimony of the apostles.

The apostles risk their life - and lose it - to defend the resurrection although they were not witnesses of the crucifixion and death. And they proclaim it boldly, as Peter does, as we read in the first reading.

2° Sense the brother.

That is to say: when we share what we are and have. When He broke the bread, the disciples of Emmaus recognized Him; in sharing the roasted fish, the apostles recognized Him.

3° Make faith alive.

Keeping His commandments is how we come to know Him, affirms Saint John. Faith is strengthened by living according to what faith asks of us. Our faith in the risen Jesus is manifested and strengthened by following Him; when we become familiar with His gospel, when we adjust our lives to His, when we maintain trust in a Jesus who is still present in our history. Although our friendship with Jesus will never be perfect, because of our numerous limitations. It is from here that we must listen to Peter who asks us: "Repent and be converted ..."

Estimados feligreses...

Según el texto evangélico de san Lucas. Los discípulos no podían "creer", que Jesús se había hecho presente: era imaginación de ellos. Pensaban que lo que veían era un fantasma. Querer palpar sus manos y pies impedía su fe. Fue necesario que se abriera su entender, captar que lo sucedido estaba anunciado en la Escritura. Jesús se los explica y es así como logran pasar la evidencia sensible a la fe. Los signos que fortalecen nuestra fe son:

1° El testimonio de los apóstoles.

Los apóstoles se juegan su vida -y la pierden- por defender la resurrección ante los testigos de la crucifixión y muerte. Y lo proclaman con valentía, como hace Pedro, según leemos en la primera lectura.

2° Sentir al hermano.

Es decir: cuando compartimos lo que somos y tenemos. Al partir el pan lo reconocieron los discípulos de Emaús; al compartir el pez asado lo reconocieron los apóstoles.

3° Hacer vida la fe.

Guardando sus mandamientos es como llegamos a conocerlo, afirma San Juan. La fe se fortalece, viviendo de acuerdo a lo que ella misma nos pide. Nuestra fe en Jesús resucitado se manifiesta, y se fortalece, siguiéndole; cuando nos familiarizamos con su evangelio, cuando acomodamos nuestra vida a la suya, cuando mantenemos la confianza en un Jesús que sigue presente en nuestra historia. Aunque nuestro seguimiento nunca será perfecto, sino con numerosas limitaciones. De allí que debemos hacer caso a Pedro que nos pide: "arrepentíos y convertíos..."



Fulfillment

It is interesting that during the Easter season, when we do not hear a reading from the Old Testament, it becomes so important. This is particularly true today. Peter's speech begins with a prayer formula familiar to Jews: "The God of Abraham . . ." (Acts 3:13). It likewise contains the potent phrases "Holy and Righteous One" and "mouth of all the prophets" (3:14, 18). Peter was stating in no uncertain terms that the law, psalms, and prophets had been fulfilled in Christ. This is reinforced by Jesus himself in the Gospel passage, when he states that everything in the scriptures (to the early Christians "the scriptures" were what we call the Old Testament) had to be fulfilled. Above all, Jesus and Peter both emphasize that we are witnesses to all of this, and are sent forth to bear witness to it in the world. The Latin Missa, from which our word "Mass" comes, means "sent" (as in "mission"). As we leave Mass today, let us remember to be witnesses to all that has been fulfilled in the risen Christ. Cumplimiento

Es interesante que durante el tiempo de Pascua, cuando no escuchamos la lectura del Antiguo Testamento, se vuelve tan importante. Esto es particularmente cierto hoy. El discurso de Pedro comienza con una fórmula de oración familiar a los judíos: "El Dios de Abraham..." (Hechos 3:13). Asimismo contiene las poderosas frases "Santo y Justo" y "boca de todos los profetas" (3:14, 18). Pedro estaba declarando sin lugar a dudas que la ley, los salmos y los profetas se habían cumplido en Cristo. Esto se ve reforzado por el mismo Jesús en el pasaje del Evangelio, cuando dice que todo en la Escritura (para los primeros cristianos "la Escritura" era lo que hoy llamamos el Antiguo Testamento) tenía que cumplirse. Por encima de todo, Jesús y Pedro hacen hincapié en que somos testigos de todo esto, y somos enviados a dar testimonio en el mundo. La palabra misa en latín, significa "enviado" (como "misión"). Al salir de la misa de hoy, recordemos ser testigos de todo lo que se ha cumplido en Cristo resucitado. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.
