Dear Parishioners...

Today, with the celebration of Pentecost (Easter of the Holy Spirit), we reach a stage of extraordinary importance. The risen Jesus has been preparing his Church for this solemnity that offers, not only rest in the journey, but also a strong impulse towards goals that are always new and alluring. The mystery of the Holy Spirit, although immeasurable in all its depth and greatness, incites us as believers to continue delving into the Revelation of God in Jesus Christ, to thank and praise it as a great blessing. It is well known that humans need images to reach the mystery of God, which is unity in the trinity. To aid our reflective intelligence comes the perception of light, wind, water, fire, breeze, heat, and respiration.

- The Holy Spirit unifies believers, like the magnitude of the lake, which is formed as a result of innumerable drops. The unifying energy of the Spirit, like that of water - moves, produces life, quenches thirst, washes, waters, rejoices with its inimitable noise - beautifies, rests, provides routes to reach desired ports.

- The Holy Spirit, like fire, gathers everyone in the house as a family. Its luminosity and warmth is the love that is shared endlessly, drives and moves; like a sun that knows neither wear nor sunset.

- The Holy Spirit, like the air or the wind, makes itself felt in multiple ways: almost imperceptible, subtle, lighter than serious, like a breeze - clear, noble, immense, vehicle of the word. Under circumstances it blows hard, raises swells, carries healthy moisture, drags clouds away, and even dissipates them. It is the source of invisible force. It moves, it moves away the polluted atmosphere, it prepares the earth for sowing, it ripens the crops, it plows through the sky, it fills everything to the deepest part, although it is less perceptible than the other elements.

This is the way the Holy Spirit is for the Church: it does not cease to encourage its members. It always provides new air: it is the life that springs from Christ and has begun in us thanks to the baptismal font. From His Spirit flow the charisms with which the Church is enriched, all permeated with love, which are like a living and inextinguishable flame. They give consistency to the universe; they are the path of holiness for all nations. They continue in our history, performing those wonders that were externalized on the first Pentecost. Let us be open and attentive to His coming.

Estimados feligreses...

Hoy, con la celebración de Pentecostés (Pascua del Espíritu Santo), llegamos a una etapa de extraordinaria importancia. Jesús resucitado ha venido preparando a su Iglesia para esta solemnidad que ofrece, no solo descanso en la andadura, sino un fuerte impulso hacia metas siempre nuevas y cada vez más atrayentes. El misterio del Espíritu Santo, aunque inabarcable en toda su profundidad y grandeza, nos incita como creyentes a continuar ahondando en la Revelación de Dios en Jesucristo para agradecerla y alabarla como gran bendición. Bien es sabido que los humanos precisamos de imágenes para llegar al misterio de Dios, que es unidad en la trinidad. En ayuda de nuestra inteligencia reflexiva viene la percepción de la luz, el viento, el agua, el fuego, la brisa, el calor y el aliento:

- El Espíritu Santo unifica a los creyentes, a semejanza de la magnitud del lago, que se forma como resultado de innumerables gotas. La energía unificadora del Espíritu, como la del agua, mueve, produce vida, apaga la sed, lava, riega, alegra con su rumor inimitable, embellece, descansa, proporciona vías para arribar a deseados puertos.

- El Espíritu Santo, igual que el fuego, reúne a todos en la casa como una familia. Su luminosidad y calor es el amor que se comparte y no se acaba, sino que impulsa y mueve; como un sol que no conoce desgaste, ni ocaso.

- El Espíritu Santo, como el aire o el viento, se deja sentir de manera múltiple: casi imperceptible, sutil, más leve que grave, a manera de brisa, claro, noble, inmenso, vehículo de la palabra. En circunstancias sopla con fuerza, levanta oleaje, transporta humedad saludable, arrastra las nubes y hasta las disipa. Es origen de fuerza invisible, mueve, aleja la atmósfera contaminada, prepara la tierra para la siembra, madura las cosechas, surca el firmamento, lo llena todo hasta lo más recóndito, aunque sea menos perceptible que los demás elementos.

Así es el Espíritu Santo para la Iglesia: no deja de alentar a sus miembros; proporciona siempre aires nuevos: es la vida que brota de Cristo y ha comenzado en nosotros gracias a la fuentes bautismal. De su Espíritu manan los carismas con que se enriquece la Iglesia, impregnados todos de amor, que son como llama viva e inextinguible. Dan consistencia al universo, son camino de santidad para todas las naciones. Continúan en el hoy de la historia realizando aquellas maravillas que se exteriorizaron en el primer Pentecostés. Estemos abiertos y atentos a su venida.
