Dear Parishioners...

The second reading, alluding to the prayer of the garden, affirms that Christ “was heard” by his father. Paradoxical expression, because the father did not save him passing through death. And yet, he was heard. The resurrection will reveal to what extent the child has been heard. To this Christ who had asked: “Father, glorify your Son,” we see it now crowned with honor and glory precisely by virtue of the passion of him and the cross of him. Moreover, once risen, brought to perfection, he has become for all who obey him in the author of eternal salvation. In the light of the resurrection we understand in all its truth that it is the grain of wheat that falls on the ground and dies to give a lot of fruit. Yes, indeed, in the deepest of the agony of him, the Son has been heard by the Father.

This is also illuminating for us. Many people complain that God does not listen to him because he does not free him from the evils he is suffering. But to His son He did not set free from death. And yet, he listened to him. God always listen. What happens is that we “do not know how to ask for what it is convenient.” God can listen to us allowing us to remain in the test and not avoiding death. He listens to us by giving us strength to resist in the test. He listens to us giving us grace to be purified and dignified. He listens to us glorifying us through suffering. He listens to us making us grain of wheat that dies to bear abundant fruit ... During this week, let us pray to the Lord to take away from us everything that leads us to sin.

Estimados feligreses...

La segunda lectura, aludiendo a la oración del huerto, afirma que Cristo «fue escuchado» por su Padre. Expresión paradójica, porque el Padre no le ahorró pasar por la muerte. Y, sin embargo, fue escuchado. La resurrección revelará hasta qué punto el Hijo ha sido escuchado. A este Cristo que había pedido: «Padre, glorifica a tu Hijo», lo vemos ahora coronado de honor y gloria precisamente en virtud de su pasión y su cruz. Más aún, una vez resucitado, llevado a la perfección, «se ha convertido para todos los que le obedecen en autor de salvación eterna». A la luz de la Resurrección entendemos en toda su verdad que es el grano de trigo que cae en tierra y muere para dar mucho fruto. Sí, efectivamente, en lo más hondo de su agonía el Hijo ha sido escuchado por el Padre.

Esto es iluminador también para nosotros. Mucha gente se queja de que Dios no le escucha porque no le libera de los males que está sufriendo. Pero a su Hijo tampoco le liberó de ni le ahorró la muerte. Y, sin embargo, le escuchó. Dios escucha siempre. Lo que ocurre es que nosotros «no sabemos pedir lo que conviene». Dios puede escucharnos permitiendo que permanezcamos en la prueba y no evitándonos la muerte. Nos escucha dándonos fuerza para resistir en la prueba. Nos escucha dándonos gracia para ser aquilatados y purificados. Nos escucha glorificándonos a través del sufrimiento. Nos escucha haciéndonos grano de trigo que muere para dar fruto abundante... Durante esta semana, pidámosle a Dios que nos aparte de todo aquello que nos lleva al pecado.
