

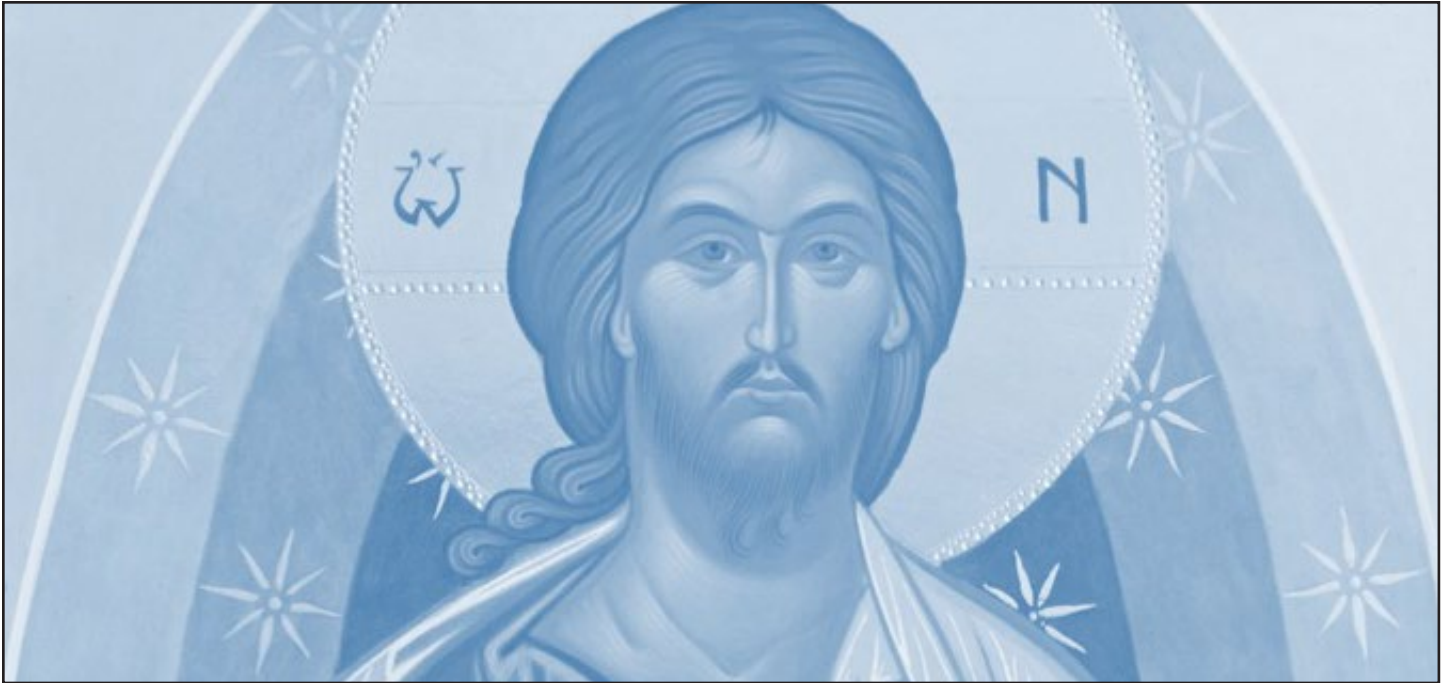

Dear Parishioners

Those who manage to have an intimate friendship with God always enrich their own lives and the lives of those who listen to them. The words spoken by the prophet are full of God. Today, in our world, there is a lot of dialogue that surround us, many the words we speak, but few the messages that really speak. We have to consider the value of the words we speak, and therefore we have to assess whether our life is a message -word- for someone. We will be a word if we nurture our relationship with God in terms of friendship and intimacy with Him.

"Proclaim the Word, insist at the right time and at the wrong time, rebuke, reproach, exhort with all patience and desire to instruct." It's the message of the Apostle Paul to Timothy. The proclamation of the word is not made away from loving others. There is no proclamation of the word if the listeners are not welcomed, considered, valued, accepted, recognized, and, why not, loved.

Christian preaching (like that of our catechists in St Bernard's) shows the effort of those humbly seeking the truth and not just trying to convince by imposition or intimidation. This is their way of being fraternal and our way of seeking to be better friends with God. From this group of people come the light and the salt. With their human and fraternal warmth, they illuminate for others the path of true life. God bless our catechists always.

Grief Support Group

Grief is a universal word. Many of us grieve because life as we once knew it is gone. We pray in Jesus' name and call out for help and hope he will answer. And we pray often knowing all is in accordance with God's will, and we have confidence that he will answer. The question is when? As good Christians, we must believe and trust in God that he will answer our prayers and petitions during our difficult challenges. No hay proclamación de la Palabra si los oyentes no se ven acogidos, considerados, valorados, aceptados, reconocidos y, porque no, queridos.

La predicación cristiana (como la de nuestros catechistas en San Bernardo) pone de manifiesto el esfuerzo de buscar con humildad la verdad de Dios y de los hombres y mujeres de cada tiempo y no en convencer por la imposición de la fuerza o la intimidación. He aquí su manera de ser fraternos y su manera de buscar ser mejores amigos de Dios. De este grupo de personas surgen la luz y la sal evangélicas. Con su calor humano y fraterno iluminan para otros el camino de la Vida verdadera. Dios bendiga siempre a nuestros catechistas.
