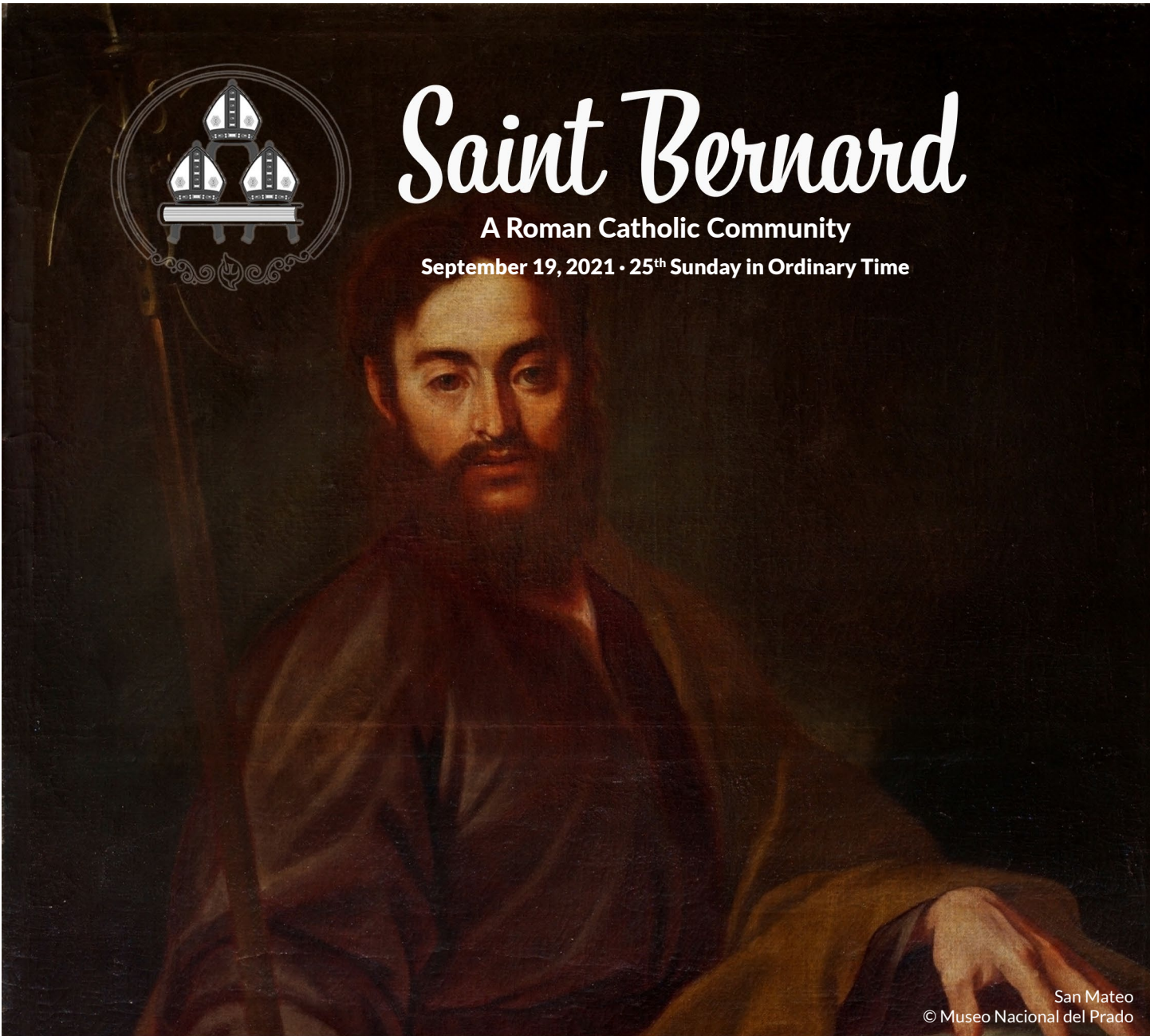

Dear Parishioners:

How sad to think that we know everything...!

For this reason, when someone dares to contradict us, we think we must silence them. Not listening to the other means a lack of appreciation, consideration, opportunity. Poverty on our part, we close ourselves off and, consequently, diminish our capacities and our very condition as human beings. Out of pride, out of fear, insecurity, envy, we adopt positions that we justify. This is what the Book of Wisdom teaches us today.

The wise man listens, the wise man meditates, the wise man contemplates, the wise man welcomes, the wise man is aware of God, who is the one who inspires his response. It is not his need, security, or desire that is the reason for his life. The wise man knows what trust is and what it means. Wisdom, however, is gentle, understanding, conciliatory, merciful, bears good fruit, impartial and sincere. Contrary to envy which is a disorder, a sign of an unsatisfied life. It is a reason for great sadness.

There were moments and spaces that Jesus dedicated mainly to his disciples who had their heads and hearts elsewhere. Some were self-centered and ambitious for their safety, power, and truth. They heard him, but they did not listen. They could not understand what Jesus was saying to them and preferred not to ask. Hence, He invited them to be like children. Because children know they are dependent on everything and open to all kinds of teaching and correction. During this week, let's pray to the Lord to make us more humble and open to his Word.

La sabiduría, sin embargo, es apacible, comprensiva, conciliadora, misericordiosa, da buenos frutos, imparcial y sincera... contraria a la envidia: esa mirada rencorosa. La envidia es un trastorno, signo de una vida insatisfecha. Es razón de mucha tristeza...

Hubo momentos y espacios que Jesús dedicó especialmente a sus discípulos que tenían su cabeza y su corazón en otro sitio. Demasiado, quizás, centrados en sí mismos y ambicionando su seguridad, su poder, su verdad. Oían, no escuchaban, no podían entender, por tanto, lo que Jesús les decía, pero tampoco preguntaban por si acaso. De allí que los invite a ser como niños porque los niños se saben dependientes de todo y abiertos a todo tipo de enseñanza y corrección. En esta semana oremos al Señor para que nos haga más humildes y abiertos a su Palabra.

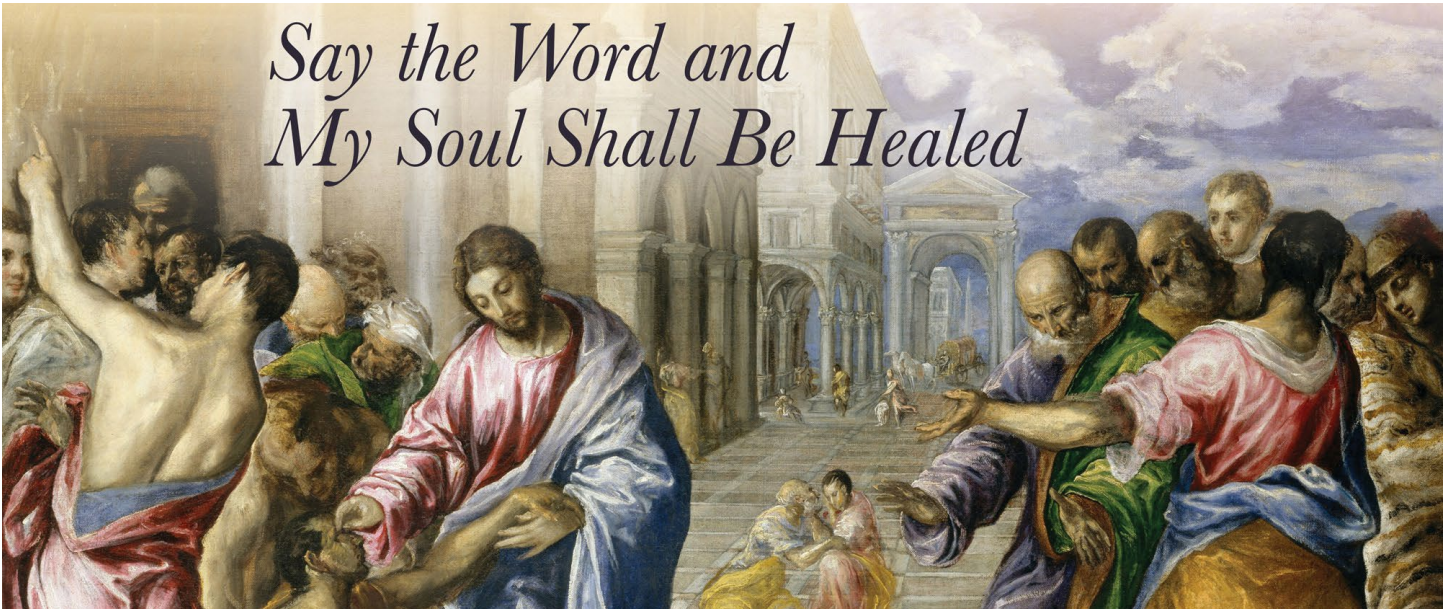
That Man is You

Each year, the Catholic Church in the United States designates the third Sunday in September as “Catechetical Sunday”— a day on which to celebrate and pray for the Church’s mission to teach the Gospel to all people. This year’s theme is “Say the Word and My Soul Shall Be Healed.” As a catechist, you are responding to a call to share the gift of faith with others, even as you deepen your own faith. This call may have reached you through your pastor, the director of your parish’s religious education program, or through your role as a Catholic school teacher. But know that this calling ultimately comes from God whose Holy Spirit inspires and guides you.

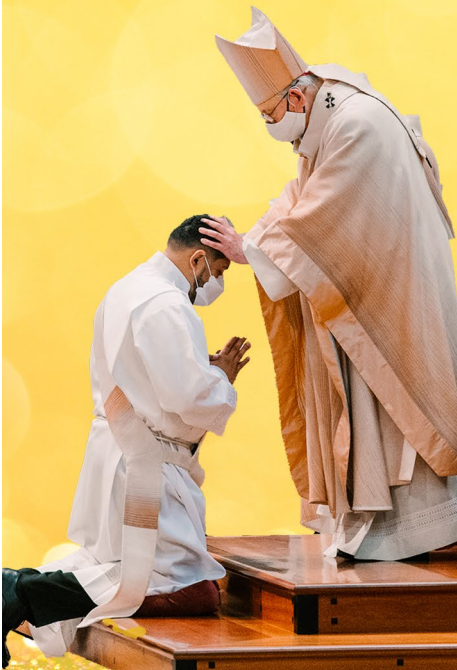
